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Kind attention is invited to the references cited. It is submitted that current accumulations in Ad-hoc CAMPA, New Delhi pertaining to Andhra Pradesh State towards the Net Present Value, Compensatory Afforestation, Catchment area treatment, Bio-diversity Conservation is around **Rs. 1,508.95 crores**. Of this the Government of India released an amount of **Rs. 89.78 crores** to the State CAMPA during 2009-2010 and an account was opened in Union Bank of India, Hyderabad.

This amount is to be spent as per the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and guidelines of Government of India on CAMPA. Accordingly the Andhra Pradesh Forest Department has prepared Annual Plan of Operations for the year 2009-2010 for an amount of **Rs. 22.77 crores** towards Compensatory Afforestation, Additional Compensatory Afforestation, Bio-diversity etc., and **Rs. 64.51 crores** towards Net Present Value. The components proposed under Net Present Value are Natural Forest Management, Forest and Wildlife Protection, Forest Fire Management, Bio-diversity Conservation, Research and Development, Capacity Building, Infrastructure Development and Maintenance.

The 1st Executive Committee of the State CAMPA in its meeting held on 23.09.2009 finalised the Annual Plan of Operations for 2009-2010 prepared by the Andhra Pradesh Forest Department. The 1st Steering Committee under the Chairmanship of the Chief Secretary to Government in its meeting held on 26.10.2009 approved the Annual Plan of Operations of CAMPA for the year 2009-2010.

The Government of India has released an amount of Rs. 8978.32 lakhs to the State CAMPA with instructions to spend the amount as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and guidelines of Government of India on CAMPA. Accordingly money was released to the CCFs / CFs under CA & NPV into their accounts through online Banking and works were taken up as per approved Annual Plan of Operations 2009-2010.

An amount of Rs. 1081.559 lakhs is spent under CAMPA during 2009-2010,ie., towards Compensatory Afforestation Rs. 354.171 lakhs was spent and under Net Present Value Rs. 727.39 Lakhs was spent. The Internal Audit of works executed during 2009-10 is under progress. The component wise details of Annual Plan of Operations 2009-2010 approved and the expenditure incurred during 2009-2010 is as follows.

However, the strengthening of income generating activities and marketing tie-ups for Vana Samrakshana Samithies (VSS) do not fit into the guidelines of A.P.State CAMPA and these activities may be promoted under schemes like NREGA and FDA.

Biodiversity Conservation:

The Special Chief Secretary to Govt., Planning Department enquired as to why no projects or activities have been proposed by A.P.Biodiversity Board in the Biodiversity Conservation component of NPV 2010-11.

Sri Ashok Kumar, IAS (Retd.) and Dr.R.Hampaiah, Chairman, A.P. Biodiversity Board, both members of the Steering Committee explained the need for including the activities / projects like *in-situ* conservation initiatives of banded krait, Yellow-throated bulbul, survey of butterflies and dragon flies and damsel flies in Eastern ghats, survey of king cobra in Eastern ghats and *in-situ* conservation Medicinal Plants Conservation Areas (MPCA) in the Biodiversity Conservation component of NPV 2010-11.

The Steering Committee agreed for inclusion of the above activities / projects of A.P. Biodiversity Board within the outlay of Rs.1,310.00 lakhs provided under Biodiversity conservation component of NPV 2010-11.

Out of the above projects under eco-tourism component the Steering Committee agreed for implementation under A.P.State CAMPA - NPV 2010-11 for the items (i), (ii) and (iv) however, necessary permissions has to be obtained under FC Act.

The item (iii) is continuation of activities already existing in Horsley hills complex and item (vi) is development in forest complex Punganur. Both these items have been agreed to by the Steering Committee for implementation under A.P.State CAMPA Eco-tourism component of NPV 2010-11.

Item (v) is an important bird habitat area at Uppalapadu (outside forest area) and the Steering Committee agreed for implementation under A.P.State CAMPA Eco-tourism component of NPV 2010-11, provided it is brought under the fold of Community Reserve (W.L.P.Act 1972).

Item (vii) is a non-forest area. However, the Steering Committee agreed for implementation under A.P.State CAMPA Eco-tourism component of NPV 2010-11 provided the land is notified under Section 24 of A.P. Forest Act and taken over by the Forest Department before execution of works.

Item (viii) and (ix) have been included in the outlay of Infrastructure Development component of NPV 2010-11 under the head construction of frontline staff residential quarters. The Steering Committee agreed for implementation of these items under Infrastructure Development component of NPV 2010-11.

Item (x) was not considered by the Steering Committee for inclusion in the CAMPA scheme.

The Steering Committee approved the outlay of Rs.289.500 lakhs for the above agreed projects out of the Rs.300.00 lakhs outlay for the Eco-tourism component of NPV 2010-11.

Capacity Building:

Information and Communication Technology (I&CT):

The Steering Committee approved the plan outlay of Rs.300.00 lakhs under the component I &CT of NPV 2010-11.

The MoEF, GOI representative CCF(Central), Bangalore suggested that Survey of India maps of forest blocks in the scale of 1:10,000 should be got prepared through Survey of India and supplied to the Forest Beat Officers. On an experimental basis this may be attempted in one District of the State under the outsourcing activities of I&CT component.

The issue of levying a green tax on coal mining, crude oil / natural gas production, power generation, etc., was discussed at length. Since they contribute to production of carbon dioxide and for sequestering carbon, a lot of tree planting activities have to be taken up to improve the environment for which funds are required through green tax. The Steering Committee proposed that the issue may be taken up by the Govt. for creation of "green cess" for afforestation purposes.
