
Adverting to your D.O. letter cited under ref (1) above on the captioned subject, a soft copy of the Annual Plan of Operations for ~~the~~ 2010-11 under STATE CAMPA is sent herewith for information and further needful action.

It is further informed that during the recent review meeting of State CAMPA, the Hon'ble Chief Minister and the Chief Secretary to Govt. of Karnataka gave instructions to the Department to take up necessary planning and preparatory works in advance under STATE CAMPA project for the current financial year ie., 2010-11, so that it becomes easy to implement and complete the stipulated works before the end of the current financial year. Accordingly, in anticipation of release of funds from Ad-hoc CAMPA, New Delhi, the initial process has been completed and all the concerned Controlling and Implementing Officers in the State have been directed to take action for all preliminary procedures regarding works to be executed under STATE CAMPA for 2010-11.

As could be seen from the approved APO for the year 2010-11, some of the works are seasonal and are to be taken up during the current monsoon season. Since, all parts of the State are receiving good rains, the monsoon seasonal works have already been started. Hence, it is once again requested to release an amount of Rs.64.23 crores to STATE CAMPA at the earliest, as approved by the State Steering Committee meeting held on 10.06.2010, so as to enable to take up and complete the works as envisaged by Govt. of India and State of Karnataka.
