NOTIFICATION

Consequent upon being approved for appointment to the Grade of Under Secretary of CSS vide Department of Personnel and Training Order No. 5/7/2011-CS.I (U) dated 11<sup>th</sup> August, 2011, the President is pleased to appoint Sh. Manoj Kumar Rai (CSL No. 6972), Section Officer of the Department of Revenue, to Grade-I (Under Secretary) of CSS, purely on ad-hoc basis in Pay Band-III (Rs. 15600- 39100) with Grade Pay of Rs. 6600/- in the Ministry of Environment and Forests with effect from the forenoon of 1<sup>st</sup> September, 2011 until further orders.

2. The ad-hoc promotion is subject to the following conditions:

- i) The ad-hoc promotion shall not confer any right to continue in the grade indefinitely or for inclusion in the Select List for regular appointment or to claim seniority in the Grade-I of CSS;
- ii) The ad-hoc appointment may be terminated at any point of time without giving any reason therefor;
- iii) The officer who has not completed/undergone level 'D' Training of the CSS shall require to undergo and successfully complete the level 'D' Training within a period of six months;
- iv) The ad-hoc promotion of the officer shall be subject to the final outcome in the OA No. 3294/2009 titled Shri P.R. Sharma vs. UOI and OA No. 2674/2009 titled pending before the CAT, New Delhi.
- v) As the CSL of SOs of 2003 is under challenge in several applications pending before the CAT, New Delhi as brought out in the DoPT OM dated 30.6.2011, publishing the CSL 2003 of SOs, the ad hoc promotion, in so far as SOs of 2003 to the grade of US is concerned, is subject to the aforesaid various court cases.
