

## REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

**Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project (CBIPMP)**  
**Consulting Services for Program Management Consultants**

1. Request for Expressions of Interest follows the general procurement notice – wb2018 for this project that appeared in *Development Business*, Date 08-05-2010.
2. The Ministry of Environment & Forests (MoEF), Govt. of India has received a loan / credit from the International Bank of Reconstruction and Development / International Development Association for the World Bank aided Capacity Building for Industrial Pollution Management Project (CBIPMP) and *inter alia* to apply part of the proceeds of this loan / credit to payment under the contract for providing the Program Management support to Ministry of Environment and Forests in project management, technical support and management in the area of hazardous and solid waste, procurement and financial management and support services and Administrative and logistic support.
3. The project objectives are (i) to build tangible human and technical capacity in selected state agencies for undertaking environmentally sound remediation of polluted sites (including hazardous waste and solid waste dump sites) (ii) to support the development of policy, institutional and methodological framework for the establishment of a National Program for Rehabilitation of Polluted Sites (NPRPS). The estimated cost of the project to be implemented for a period of five years, is USD 75.39 million.
3. The Program Management Consultants (PMC), under the overall oversight of the Project Director, MoEF will be responsible managing the project implementation comprising (i) overall project management and monitoring (ii) Technical supervision of MoEF activities and monitoring activities in the project states in Andhra Pradesh and West Bengal (iii) Procurement and Financial Management Support and (iv) administrative and logistic support.
4. The MoEF now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments and availability of appropriate skills among staff etc.). Consultant may associate to enhance their qualification.
5. A Consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures as per World Bank procurement guidelines “Selection and employment of consultants by World Bank borrowers May, 2004, modified in October, 2006 & May 2010.

7. Expression of Interest must be delivered to the address by no later than 15/10/2010 from the date of publication.
