Terms and conditions for leasing out space for sale of Books on wild life and Nature in the National Zoological Park for the period from 01.09.2011 to 31.08.2012.

Terms and conditions

1. The interested party has to submit his quotation for obtaining space for sale of WWF Books in the National Zoological Park for the period from 01.09.2011 to 31.08.2012 in the sealed quotation in the prescribed Performa up to 29.08.2011 at 3.30 PM. He can inspect the site before submission of quotation.
2. He has to submit an amount of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty only) as earnest money deposit in the form of demand draft in favour of Director, National Zoological Park, New Delhi from a Nationalized Bank alongwith this quotation failing which the tender will be rejected on the spot.
3. The successful party has to submit a security deposit of Rs.40,000/- (Rupees forty thousand only) in the form of fixed deposit in the nationalized bank. The security deposit would be returned after completion of the tender period. In case of any breach of terms and conditions or unsatisfactory performance or other lapses the security deposit would be forfeited to Government. The decision of the Director National Zoological Park would be final binding on this matter.

4. The successful party has to submit the list of persons to be engaged so that necessary Gate pass shall be issued in his favour.
5. The successful party has to pay the wages etc. to the persons to be engaged keeping in view of the Minimum wages Act of the Government. He shall bear EPF and other liabilities. The National Zoological Park will not be responsible for the workers engaged by him.
6. The Director, National Zoological Park will cancel the contract at any time without assigning any reasons. In other works the contract can be cancelled in any period between 01.09.2011 to 31.08.2012.
7. He shall be personally responsible for retaining and safe custody of the belongings entrusted to him be the visitors. Any claim of lost / compensation etc. shall be paid by him and the National Zoological Park will not hold any responsibility to the above. He shall settle police affairs court cases, if any, and National Zoological park will not hold any responsibility on this.
8. The Director, National Zoological Park is not bound to accept the highest bid. He reserves the right to accept highest or lowest rate at his own discretion.
9. The Director, National Zoological Park at any time by notice in writing can terminate the contract without any compensation if the contractor commits any breach of the contract he shall also reserves the right to impose monetary penalty at his discretion of the extent up to one month licence fee on each occasion or actual loss occurred to Government whichever is higher.
10. The period of contract is w.e.f. 01.09.2011 to 31.08.2012.
11. He has to execute an agreement in the non-judicial stamp paper of Rs.100/- proforma to be furnished by National Zoological Park within 15 days after acceptance of offer.

12. The contractor should ensure that he will sale the Books on Wild life and Nature the MRP only and there should be no complaint against him from any corner.

13. He will not undertake sale of other articles other then the Books on wild life and Nature. In case if it is found that he his selling other articles, his contract shall be summarily cancelled without notice and security money shall be forfeited to the Government accounts.

14. In case of downloading the quotation form Profoma from website a demand draft of Rs. 200/- (quotation form cost) should be attached along with the quotation form.

15. The terms and conditions shall remain the same and no change is possible regarding site or any other facilities.
