**Sub: Reconstitution of Indian National MAB Committee.**

It has been decided to reconstitute the Indian National Man and Biosphere (MAB) Committee under the Chairpersonship of Additional Secretary (Conservation) in this Ministry with the following composition:

**2. Mandate of the Committee is as follows:**

- (a) Advice on policy and programme formulation for Biosphere Reserves (BRs).
- (b) Lay down guidelines for preparation of Management Action Plans for BRs.
- (c) Review the progress of programme implementation in Biosphere Reserves.
- (d) Suggest priority areas and recommend research proposals related to the BRs for funding.
- (e) Approval of proposals for designation of new BRs.
- (f) Carry out any other functions which may be necessary from time to time for achieving the overall mandate of the programme.
- (g) To advice on inter-State issues relating to BRs falling in more than one State. Accordingly *the Sub-Committee constituted vide Order No. 9/1/2008-CS/BR dated 22.5.2008 in this regard stands withdrawn.*

**3. The Terms of Reference of the Committee are as follows:**

- The Chairperson of the Committee may co-opt experts, whenever considered necessary.
- The Committee will meet at least once in a year at the venue and date as decided by the Chairperson.
- TA/DA including sitting charges @ 1000/day to the non-official members will be borne by the Ministry as per Rules.
- The Non official members of the Committee headed by the Chairperson shall form core group for research projects under BRs and shall meet at least twice a year.
- The tenure of the committee will be for 3 years from the date of issuance of this office Order or till reconstituted.
