Agenda Item No. 01: Import of waste/used rubber tyres for production of Tyre Pyrolysis Oil- Royal Carbon Black Private Limited (TPO)(12-40/2013-HSMD):

With regard to decision of the Committee in the 35th TRC Meeting on the issue of safeguards for Tyre Pyrolysis Oil, Royal Carbon Black Private Limited have suggestions to protect the environment and to prevent adulteration (**Annexure I**).

The applicant has suggested to consider the points while inspecting different pyrolysis plants and drafting the final policy parameters to grant permission to import Tyre Scrap for Manufacture of TPO and also has emphasized to stress on the removal of steel from the batch type reactors being a very polluting activity & therefore should not be encouraged.

The committee may deliberate on the information provided by the applicant for formulating the safeguards with respect to Tyre Pyrolysis Oil.

AGENDA ITEM NO 02: M/s Shiva Petro - Synth Specialties Ltd, Mumbai.- Clarification for inter-state movement of used/ Waste oil as per the rules 20(3) of Gazettes Notification of Hazardous Waste Rules, 2008 (23-213/2014-HSMD)

The matter was considered in the 35th TRC meeting held on 20th February 2015. The committee noted that the reason why Goa PCB was not allowing inter-state movement of Hazardous Waste (used oil/waste oil) since, the recyclers outside Goa were not filling returns on Form 4 as well as Form 6 as required under the H.W. Rule,2008. The applicant is therefore advised to make sure that the recyclers outside the State of Goa also file the returns to the respective SPCB (including Goa) from whose jurisdiction the Hazardous

waste were obtained for recycling. The committee noted that there is lack of clarity on sending the returns of waste disposed or recycled from one state to another. Since, the GOA PCB seems to have insisted on getting returns from recyclers in the other state of waste generated in their state (Goa), the recyclers may be advised to send returns to both the State Boards. Applicant is advised to act as per the recommendation.

Representation received from M/s Shiva Petro – Synth Specialties Ltd, Mumbai with respect to the aforesaid decision of the Committee. The applicant has informed that they have submitted the annual returns in Form 4 and Form 12(copy enclosed with the letter) to Goa Pollution Control Board, the receipt has been duly acknowledged as is evident from the acknowledgement on letter. The applicant has mentioned that the stand taken by GPCB is just to hamper their upliftment of contracted quantities of used/waste oil and give monopoly to only one party registered in the state of Goa. The applicant has requested the Ministry to give clear instructions to GPCB to allow them upliftment as per the law.

The committee may deliberate the on the issue of annual returns as informed.

AGENDA ITEM NO 03: Export of Slag from Precious Metals processing for further refining intimation- M/s Hindalco Industries Limited

The applicant has informed that they will be exporting the slag for further refining in terms of Basel Convention Schedule III Part B Annexure IX of the Basel convention (No. B1100)

The committee may deliberate on the issue with regard to the Hazardous Waste Rules, 2008.

AGENDA ITEM NO 04: Finalization of Standard Operating Procedures with regard to import of Waste Pneumatic Tyres for recycling- reg

Waste pneumatic tyres are imported in the country for recycling, resource recovery and for utilization as supplementary resource.

SOPs for considering such applications for import have been developed by CPCB (**Annexure 2**) and is presented for discussion and recommendation by the committee for finalization .

AGENDA ITEM NO 05: Finalization of Standard Operating Procedures with regard to import of Used PET Bottle Scrap/ plastic scrap for recycling -reg.

PET Bottle Scrap are recycled for production of PET flakes or polyester fibers for use in the making of staple fibre, pillows, carpets, polyester sheets, strapping.

SOPs for considering such applications for import have been developed by CPCB (**Annexure 3**) and is presented for discussion and recommendation by the committee for finalization

AGENDA ITEM NO 06: Finalization of Standard Operating Procedures with regard to import of lead scrap for Secondary Lead Recycling Units-reg.

Lead scrap/waste such as scrap full lead acid battery, Lead acid battery plates and other lead scrap are imported for recycling for production of lead through secondary recycling procedures.

SOPs for considering such applications for import have been developed by CPCB (**Annexure 4**) and is presented for discussion and recommendation by the committee for finalization
