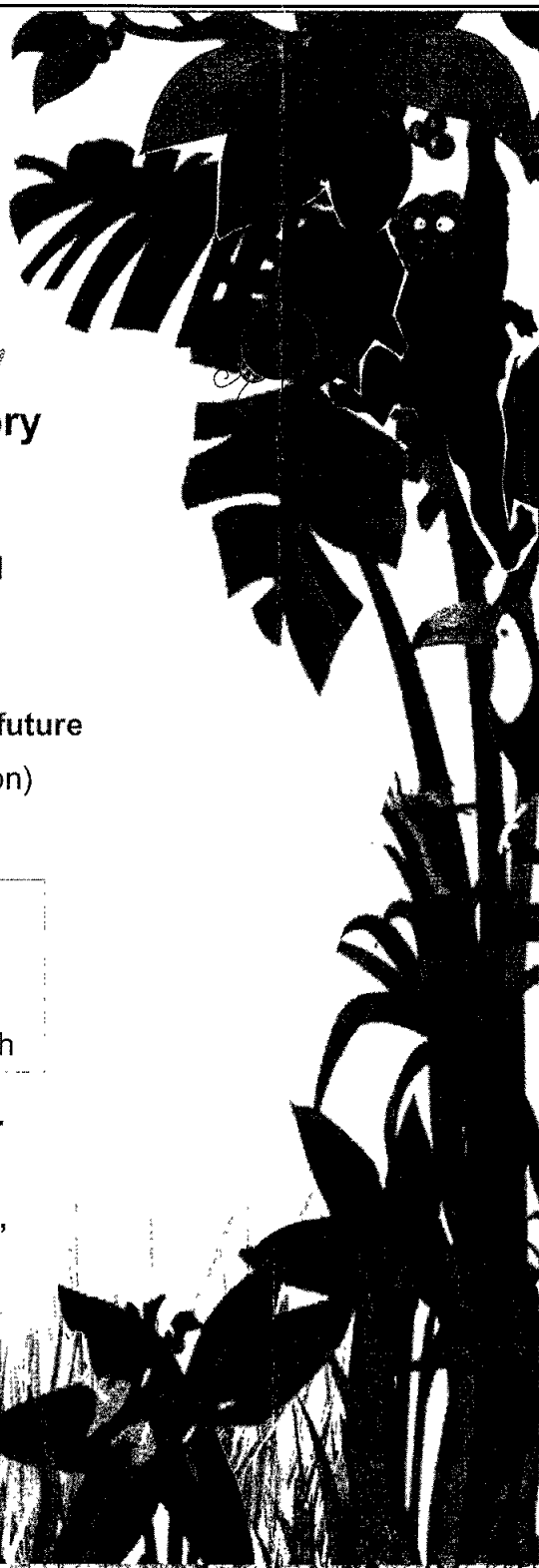
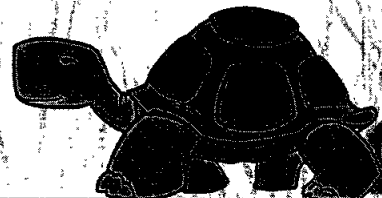
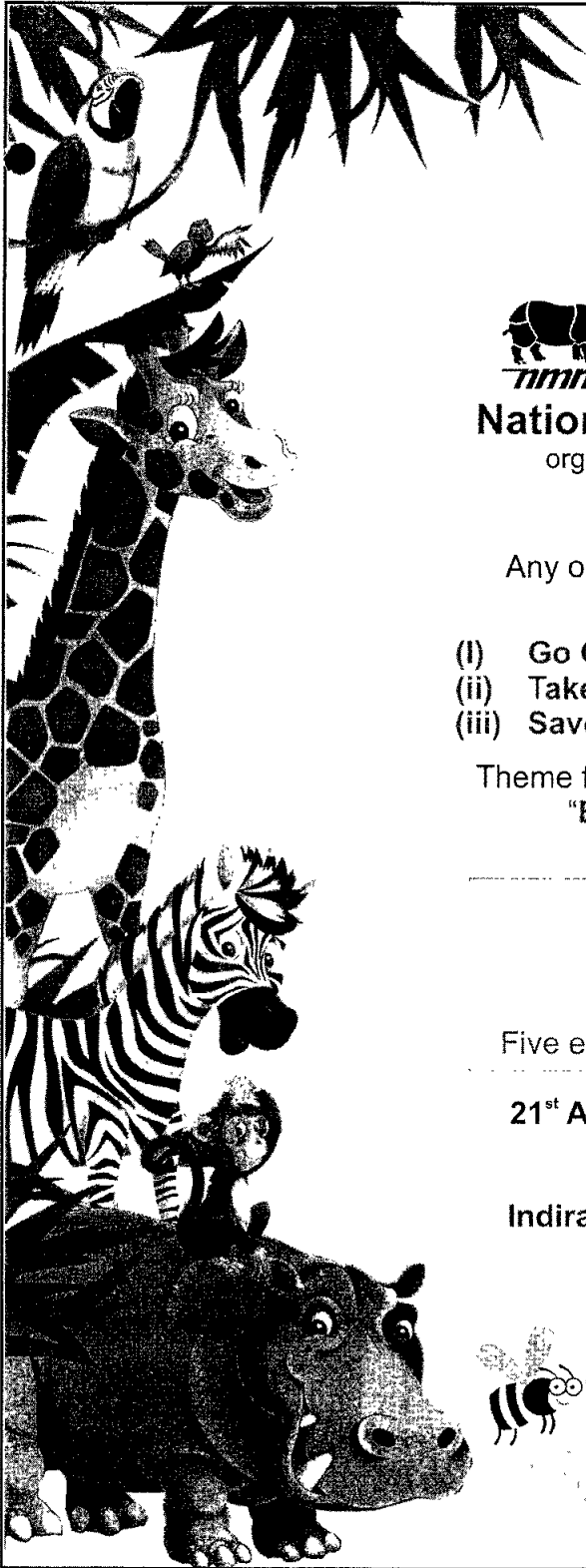

To commemorate "Earth Day-2017", NMNH is organizing competitions and create awareness among children to build a healthy, sustainable environment, address climate change, and protect the Earth for future generations.

The competitions are open for the students from classes IX to XII of schools in Delhi-NCR.

Date: Friday, 21st April, 2017

Time: 10:30 AM to 12:30 PM

The competitions will be conducted in two categories as following:

1. **Category I: Poem Writing Competition**
2. **Category II: Essay Writing Competition**

The **poems** should be original and self made which can be written on any one of the following themes either in Hindi or English (not more than 20 lines).

- a) Go Green for Life
- b) Take care of beautiful Earth
- c) Save the Earth to save the hope of life in future

The **Theme for Essay writing competition** is - "Environmental and Climate Literacy"
The word limit for essay writing is 300 words.

Writing papers will be provided by the museum. The participants may bring their own writing board, pen/pencil and other stationery material, etc.

All the entries will the sole property of the museum and it will have the right to use it for any purpose it considers appropriate.

The evaluation of the poem and essay writing copies will be done by a panel of Judges nominated by NMNH.

Prizes in each category:

First Prize worth Rs.3000/-

Second Prize worth Rs.2000/-

Third Prize worth Rs.1000/-

Five encouragement Prizes worth Rs.500/- each.

The prizes and certificates will be awarded during the Prize Distribution Function to be held along with Valediction of Summer Vacation Programme-2017. All the winners will be informed accordingly.

Each school may send **4 numbers of interested participants (2 participants in each category)** to participate in the competitions to be held on **Friday, 21st April, 2017 from 10:30 am to 12:30 pm Indira Paryavaran Bhawan, Jor Bagh Road, New Delhi-3.**
