## Campus Information

National Institute of Animal Welfare (NIAW) is a subordinate office of Government of India under the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, set up in a sprawling campus on 8 Acres of land at Ballabhgarh, Faridabad, Haryana.



### **Objectives:**

To create enabling environment for fulfilment of the statutory requirement as laid down in the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960.

### **Scope:**

To impart training and education on diversified subjects in animal welfare including animal management, behaviour and ethics with a purpose to foster knowledge to personnel working with animals in the State Veterinary Departments, Municipal Corporations, Forensic Laboratories, Forestry Departments, Laboratories dealing with animal experimentation, sanctuaries, animal houses/ shelters, pharmaceuticals, diagnostic laboratories, members/ nominees of Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI), CPCSEA, Socially Aware Nominees, SPCAs, Institutional Animal Ethics Committee (IAEC) members, Animal Welfare Organizations (AWOs, NGOs registered with AWBI, Students graduating in Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Fisheries Science, Wild Life Sciences, Biological Sciences etc.

## GUIDE TO SERVICES

### Accommodation:

On campus accommodation will be provided to the participants on twin sharing basis in the Hostel of the Institute.

Both boarding and lodging shall be free of cost to the participants.

Spouses, family members, children, guests or friends are not permitted in the campus.
